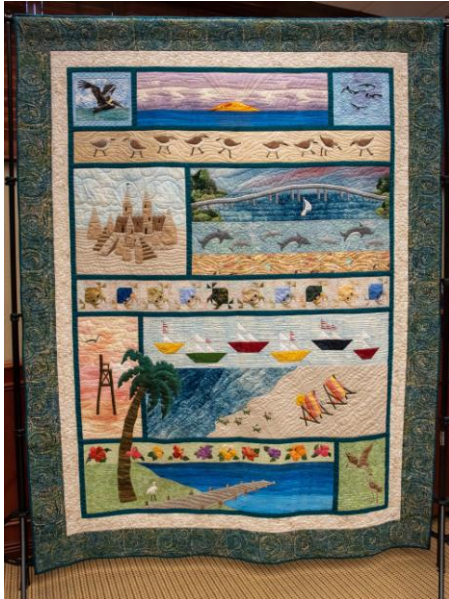


Sunbonnet Sue Centennial Quilt Displayed at City Council Meeting
