

Walking Tree Centennial Brew

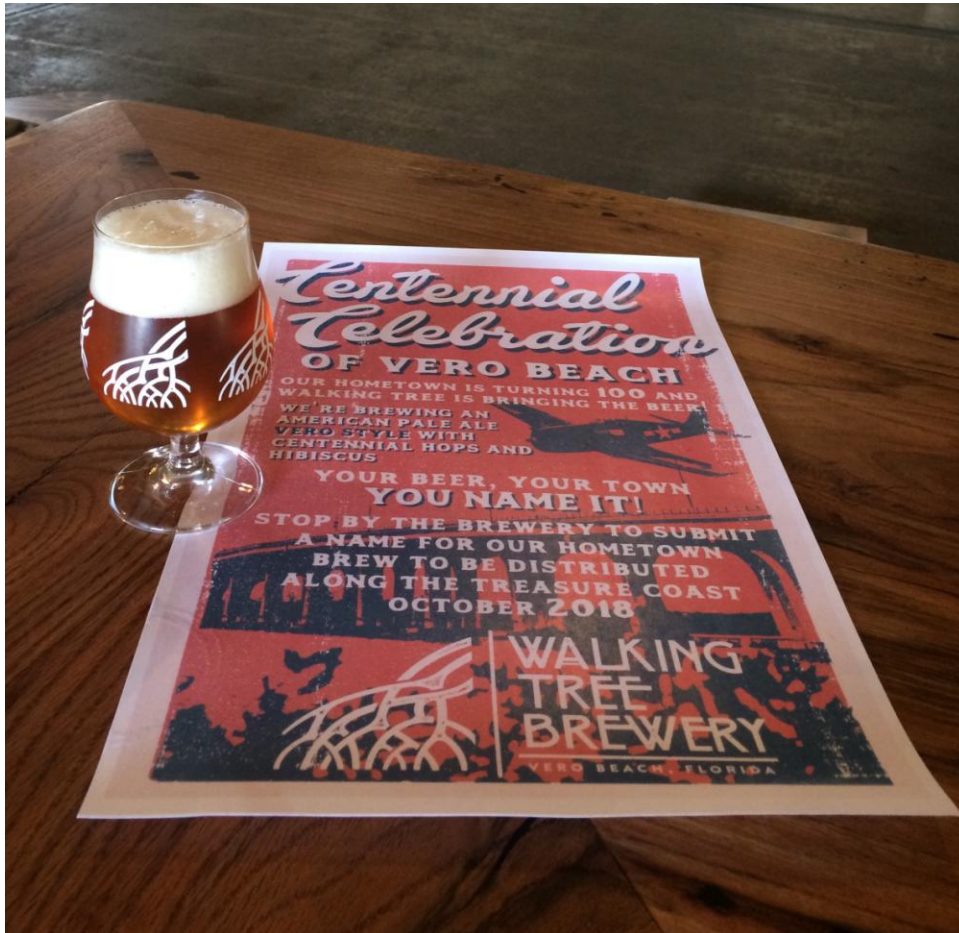

The winning name of **Circa 1919** (based on the year that the City of Vero Beach was incorporated), was suggested by Jordan Farrow (a Walking Tree employee) in a blind voting process.

For anyone interested in a taste or two or more, Walking Tree Brewery will be tapping the beer on Friday, October 12 at noon and then distributed at the Centennial Chili Challenge, Saturday, October 27 from 4:00–9:00 p.m. at Riverside Park by the River in Vero Beach.
